AIDA Weekly Classes Tuition and Fees



Tuition

Tuition for weekly classes is *determined by the number of classes (including the final rehearsals and showcases(s) per season.* It is NOT a monthly fee. *Please see class descriptions for pricing*

Tuition may be paid in two formats:

*Full tuition- Pay in full at registration or pay in full by the fifth day of the first month. (ie Sept 5 or Jan 5) *Installments-Due by the 5th day of the month for the current season. Discounts available when combining some classes. Exclusions apply

> Tuition is non-transferable (season to season) and non refundable. Please see AIDA Studio Policies for full details including withdrawal, make up classes, etc. included at the end of this handout.

Tuition covers all instructional classes, showcase and rehearsal. Tuition does not cover class materials, costume fees, tickets and other showcase expenses.

A non-refundable deposit will be due at registration. This will be deducted from your balance.* All families must have an account with a credit card on file. Tuition will be auto drafted/charged to the card according to the payment schedule at registration. This will be clear at checkout and will be listed on the receipt for payment. *Deposit will vary by class. See class descriptions for details

All registrations and payments are made online via Sawyer. Sawyer charges a booking/account management fee based on the total cost of each order. Any issues regarding account info, passwords, etc should be made directly to Sawyer.

Showcase Fees

FV Arts Center Performers= \$60/costume (older dancers in multiple classes, this fee could vary based on rentals, etc) In Studio Dance Performers \$50/costume Gymnastics \$10/child Drama (Madagascar) \$80/student (students who do dance and drama will pay both fees as they apply) Dramaworks Jr. \$80/season/child

> These fees will apply to both winter and spring shows. Winter Fees are due Oct 1 Spring Fees are due Feb 1 Dramaworks (Madagascar) are due Oct 1

Tickets

Showcase fees DO NOT include tickets.

FV Arts Center Students may be assigned to a show to purchase tickets.

(Meaning, if applicable, students may perform in both shows but be assigned which show to buy tickets for). Students will be given a limit to the number of tickets they can purchase until a date in which ticket sales will open to the public and can be purchased to either show. Families will be able to get their allotted tickets \$10/each during the priority purchase period before tickets go on sale to the public. All public tickets will be \$12

> **NEW this year** *In Studio dance showcase will now require tickets.* Tickets will be \$10/family and students will be limited to 2 guests/family.

Early Childhood Toddler to Age 7 yrs

Focusing on fun and creativity, our youngest dancers learn basic ballet/tap skills and terminology. Students will enjoy monthly themes, props and more designed to teach social skills while building creativty and confidence. (Students must be the required age by the first day of class)

Mini-Artists Toddlers to Age 3

Students will explore the basics of movement, music and tumbling. No special dress required. (parent/guardian participation required) Mon 9:30, Tues 9:30, or Thurs 10:00

Showcase Info

Students in our early childhood program perform ONE dance per class per showcase. All students (exc. Mini-Artist) will perform either at FV Arts Center or at our in house showcase.



Discover Dance (Ages 6-15)

Classes designed to fit into your child's active schedule! This selection of classes is perfect for the dancer that wants to dance and have fun. Our tweens and teens enjoy progressive technique classes designed to challenge them with age appropriate movement and music. Students at this level participate in outreach events and special performances. (Students must be the required age by first day of class)



Students will enjoy learning fundamentals of these styles in a relaxed environment perfect for beginners or students who don't want the pressure of our leveled classes. One year of Creative Ballet/Tap required for students age 6 before joining this class.

Elementary Ages 6-9 yrs

Combination ballet/jazz/tap class.

Dress code: Class leotard, tights, ballet shoes, tap shoes, hair pulled back and out of face. (bun preferred) Students may wear a skirt/shorts for ballet and then black yoga pants for jazz/tap. Please see AIDA Boutique for details

Tuition

A \$15/class non-refundable deposit will be required to hold your spot. This will be deducted from your total due. 45 min \$252/season or \$60/installment (after deposit) 30 min \$201/season or\$50/installment *COMBINE CLASSES AND GET 10% OFF PER CLASS

A class leotard is required for this class. It may be used as a base for a costume as well.

Our Dance Pro-gressions classes are designed to meet both the social and technical levels of our students in a pre-professional manner for a variety of dance styles. Discipline, committed training and class participation along with class dress codes is expected of students in this series. Special performance opportunities (in addition to showcase and recital) may be offered for this series. *ALL CLASSES WILL REQUIRE PLACEMENT BY THE DIRECTOR.

What to Expect

Ballet/Pointe

Classical ballet technique that combines grace, movement precision with focus on body placement and technique to enhance all styles of dance. Students will work towards being en pointe under the guidance of trained ballet teachers. Students must pass a series of skills before being allowed en pointe. *Pointe students should take 2 ballet classes/wk.

Dress Code: Class leotard, class skirt or black fitted shorts, pink tights, split sole ballet shoes, hair in bun. (Please see AIDA Boutique for a full list of your child's class requirements) Level 1/2 Tues 5:15-6:15 Level 3/4 Mon 6:00-7:00 and Wed 6:30-7:30 (*this is a two day class*)

Jazz

Combines ballet, lyrical and popular dance styles that combines specialize body movement, and rhythmic stylings. Students will explore a variety of styles from commericial, pop, broadway and more.

Dress Code: AIDA tank top, or class leotard, black leggings, jazz shoes, hair pulled out of face Jazz/Tap 1/2 Tues 6:15-7:15 Jazz 3/4 (*company*) Mon 7:00-7:45 *invitation only

Featuring classes designed to introduce students toddlers to Age 7 to early gymnastics skills. Our gymnastics classes enjoy learning with a variety of equipment including soft mats, balance beam, gymnastics bar and more! We recommend comfortable clothing for boys and a gymnastics leotard for girls. An end of season showcase will give students a chance to show off their new skills.

What do I need for class?

This document outlines the specified clothing required for each class. Appropriate clothing, shoes and hair create a full learning experience. Younger dancers have more flexibility in their dress allowing for creativity, while older dancers have a more professional dress code to keep their focus on dance and allow optimal visibility of lines and placement for instructors.

*Be sure to check out our expanded line of skin tone shoes, tights and leotards for that perfect match and clean lines.

A couple of reminders:

Dance shoes should NOT be worn outside of the studio. Street shoes are NOT allowed on the studio floor, this includes dance shoes that have been worn outside.

> Modesty is required of all students. No crop tops or booty shorts are allowed. Older dancers should be modestly covered when entering and exiting the studio. No jewelry, watches etc except medical alert. Classes with a dress code, no visible undergarments. Tights, yoga pants or fitted athletic shorts are required for ALL students. Gymnasts included. No "bare" bottoms. Students not in appropriate clothing may not be allowed to take class. Leveled students without proper attire will be asked to watch.

Forget your shoes, no problem. We can work around that for a class.

**PLEASE SCHEDULE A TIME TO BE FITTED FOR SHOES. We will do our best to do it on your class day, but this will depend on staffing. Teachers should not be pulled from class to do fittings.

Only registered students may participate in classes/special events/performances.

Participants assume all risks of liability associated with classes, programs, events and performances. AIDA staff and the owner of 118. E. Jones St. shall not be held liable in the event of illness or injury.

Medical/Emergency

All registered students MUST have an emergency phone number on file.

Arts Inspired Dance Academy has the authority to make all decisions regarding medical/dental emergencies in the absence of a legal

parent/guardian.

In the event of a major medical/dental emergency, and a parent/guardian or other authorized person is not present, the following procedure will take place in this order:

911 called and an ambulance will be ordered if necessary

Parent/Guardian will continue to be contacted.

Emergency contact if parent/guardian is unavailable or EMS arrives before a parent/ guardian is reached.

In the event of an emergency and a parent or legal guardian is not present, Arts Inspired will have the authority to

authorize medical/dental treatment for the participant

Photo/Video/Social Media

Photo and Video is allowed during open class times, special events and performance unless otherwise noted. Arts Inspired and it's agents or employees, are hereby given permission to use photographs, videos or images of me, of the minor child for use in

studio publications including brochures, newspapers, social media and the Arts Inspired website.

Arts Inspired has the unrestricted right to use and publish photography or video footage taken of me while participating in dance class, performing or in the company of Arts Inspired.

Any right to royalties or other compensation arising from the use of my photograph is waived.

I agree on my own behalf and on behalf of the minor child named below, to release and hold harmless Arts Inspired and it's agents or employees from any claims arising from the related use of the photographs.

Arts Inspired has full copyright and authority to publish photography and I agree to the terms listed above.

I understand that if I do not want images of my dependent to be used, I will indicate this in writing at registration.

Expectations for Parents/Guests:

To maintain an optimal learning environment, in class viewing is not allowed except with special permission. (out of town guests, trial class and new students)

Open House will be held the first day of class for NEW students and again mid way through the season for all clases.

Observation is allowed with the understanding that: Talking is not allowed by guests and disruptive guests will be asked to leave. Guests should not "instruct" or distract students .

Lobby is only open to parents of students age 3 and under. Please limit siblings as space is limited. We encourage all guests to enjoy our benches outside, take a walk or enjoy playing in the field (at your own risk).

No food/drink in lobby or studios.

Please be courteous to the other students and have your child to class on time.

Children should be dressed, including shoes on and ready to begin as soon as the instructor arrives.

Late Students-To avoid disruption and for the safety of students, late students should wait at the door until the instructor invites you in. Dancer should be dressed, including shoes, before entering.

Students should be picked up promptly following class times.

Parking-For the safety of your children, parking is in the lot across from the studio. NO PARKING ON STREET. Please use our "rainy day" plan for drop off/pick up as it applies. (Attached)

Code of Conduct

All students/parents are expected to behave with kindness and respect towards teachers, guests, administrators and students.

Bullying will not tolerated. (This includes in person, cyber, social media or any other format)

Students who do not comply will be asked to withdraw.

Performance etiquette- Students who miss more than 2 consecutive classes and more than 3 classes in a season will not be allowed to perform.

AIDA Studio Policies



Tuition and fees

Tuition is calculated by the season based on the total number of classes for that season.

Tuition may be paid in installments, or by the semester.

Installments are due by the 5th day of each month and are considered late on the 10th of the month. (\$25 late fee will

apply) Installment option and payment due will be outlined at checkout. .

Semester tuition is due by the 5th day of the first month.

All accounts will be required to keep a credit card on file. Tuition will be automatically deducted on the 5th of the month.

NSF or returned checks will be charged \$25 plus the bank returned check fee.

An email will be received from Sawyer in the event your payment does not process. Please update your card immediately so that payment will process or contact AIDA for special circumstance. After the third attempt to collect payment, AIDA will contact you and \$25 fee will incur and student will be withdrawn from class if no response in 24 hours.

Tuition fees will NOT be adjusted due to missed classes for illness, inclement weather, etc

Classes missed due to injury, illness or vacation may be made up in the current season with prior notice.

Withdrawal Policy

A 30 day written notice is required by all students for withdrawal. Registration/showcase/recital fees are not refundable .

Withdrawal begins on the first day of the full month following the written notice.

Absences due to vacation, illness, additional activities will not be excused from tuition.

A student who will be out for an extended period but plans to return to class has two options:

1. Withdraw from AIDA. Student can return to class if a spot is available, and/or complies with performance/special events policies. Tuition will not be charged during this time.

2. Pay tuition during the missed classes to guarantee a reserved spot when they return. Participation in performance special events will be at the instructors discretion. (Please see performance/outreach event policies)

Illness Protocol

Students that are feeling symptoms of any illness, or have anyone that is displaying symptoms of illness should stay home at least 48 hours after illness before returning to class or follow the recommendations of the physician for quarantine.

Online classes will remain an option for anyone that chooses for missed classes.

8. Classes cancelled by the instructor will be given a makeup option within the current dance season.

9. In the event of inclement weather or other condition, classes may be held online. Arts Inspired does NOT follow the school system for

closings and delays.

Inclement Weather You will be notified via Remind and Private FB group of decisions regarding closures due to inclement weather at least 2 hours prior to class time. We will follow FVPD for our decision. Classes may be held online.

Transportation

All students that will be transported by AIDA must agree to the transportation waiver.

I authorize Arts Inspired Dance Academy, LLC. to transport my minor child in a company Bus or Van, driven by an individual authorized by Arts Inspired Dance Academy, LLC.

I understand my child is expected to follow all applicable laws regarding riding in a motor vehicle and is expected to follow the directions provided by the driver and/or staff or volunteer.

I understand participation in the identified event is not a requirement for participation in the program.

I have read, understand, and discussed with my child:

(1) My child will travel in a motor vehicle driven by an adult and my child is to wear their safety belt and use the proper restraining device as mandated by state guidelines during travel;

(2) My child is expected to listen to supervising staff/driver, respect sta and other children, the vehicles they ride in, and the people they travel with during the trip;

(3) Riding in a motor vehicle may result in personal injuries or death from wrecks, collisions or acts by riders,

other drivers, or objects; and,

(4) My child is to remain in their seat and not be disruptive to the driver of the vehicle.
